FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK

Summer is finally upon us, it's important to remember some basic safety as we start to get out and enjoy ourselves.

Safe Grilling Tips

- ◆ Make sure the grill has been moved at least 10-feet away from the building before cooking and heating up the grill.
- ◆ Clean the grill surface and have the grill hot before cooking.
- ◆ Thaw and marinate foods in refrigerator
- ◆ Grill food thoroughly. Use a thermometer to be sure meat is fully cooked.
- ◆ Don't let raw juices from uncooked meat, poultry or fish come into contact with cooked meat, poultry or fish, ready-to-eat food,
- ◆ Store leftovers in the refrigerator or freezer within two hours of taking food off the grill. In hot weather (above 90 degrees), food should never set out for more than one hour.
- ◆ Clean the grill once done cooking and after grill has been cooled, move the grill back into the garage for storage.

Remember that children's wading/swimming pools are NOT allowed due to insurance restrictions and subdivision covenants. They are considered drowning/trip hazards and may not be on the property for any reason.

Effective January 1, 2023, you are responsible to maintain your lawn. We will be out before mowing season next year to mark off the yards.

Lawn mowers are to be stored in your garage and you will be allowed to store the gas can in the garage for your mower. Gas cans are not allowed to be stored inside the home.

- ◆ CO/Smoke detector beeping or chirping

Also fire, flood, or anything that threatens life, safety or property damage.
